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CHAPTER 1 OUTLINE

1.1. Device Configuration

The Figure I-1-1 is the photo image of the F50-bill dispenser unit.

Bill capacity: 1,500mm(max)

(ex: 1,000 USD notes for teller fit, 1,200 USD notes for brand-new notes)

Number of dispensing per transaction: 20sheets (max)

CHAPTER 2 F50-BDU

2.1. F50-BDU (Part No.: KD11078-B002)

2.1.1 Parts

Door: Door for F50-BDU

Reject area: Storage are for rejected bills

Tray: Exit tray

Manual knob: Manual knob for jammed bill removal

Pressure unit: Bill pressure mechanism





2.1.2 Loading bills

Hold green colored handle(bill holder handle) and slides the bill holder until it locks.

Note: Ensure that Pressure unit is completely locked.



(1) Load bills

Note: Jog a stack of bills and set.

Max loading capacity is 1,200 USD notes for brand-new notes.

(2) Hold the bill holder handle, and then slide the bill holder to secure the bills.



(4) Close the Door completely.





2.1.3 Care instructions of bills before loading

Following care need to be done before loading bills:


(1) Riffle the stack of bills before loading.




(2) Find and get rid of shifted bill before loading.




(3) Load bills in staggered units of 100 sheets so that the stack of bills does not bulge.



(4) Straighter any folded corners of bills as much as possible before loading.



(5) Do not use bills repaired with tape.



CHAPTER 3 REMOVE LEFT BILLS

3.1. How to remove a jammed bill.

Generally for an abnormal end, device is recovered by the mechanical reset command, however, if device is suspended because of a jam, bill jam in the unit need to be removed by hand.

3.1.1. How to remove the jam on the transportation pathway



While turning the manual knob, move the jammed bill to the position as figure I 3-1 shows. Then remove jammed bill.



While turning the manual knob, take out a bill slowly.

Note: If you pull the bill by force, belt comes off from the pulley.



Check pulleys in three places as Figure I-3-3 shows, and ensure that belt isn't off from the belt.

3.1.2. How to remove jammed bill at dispensing area



While pressing down the metal fitting of dispensing roller, turn the manual knob and pull jammed bill.
